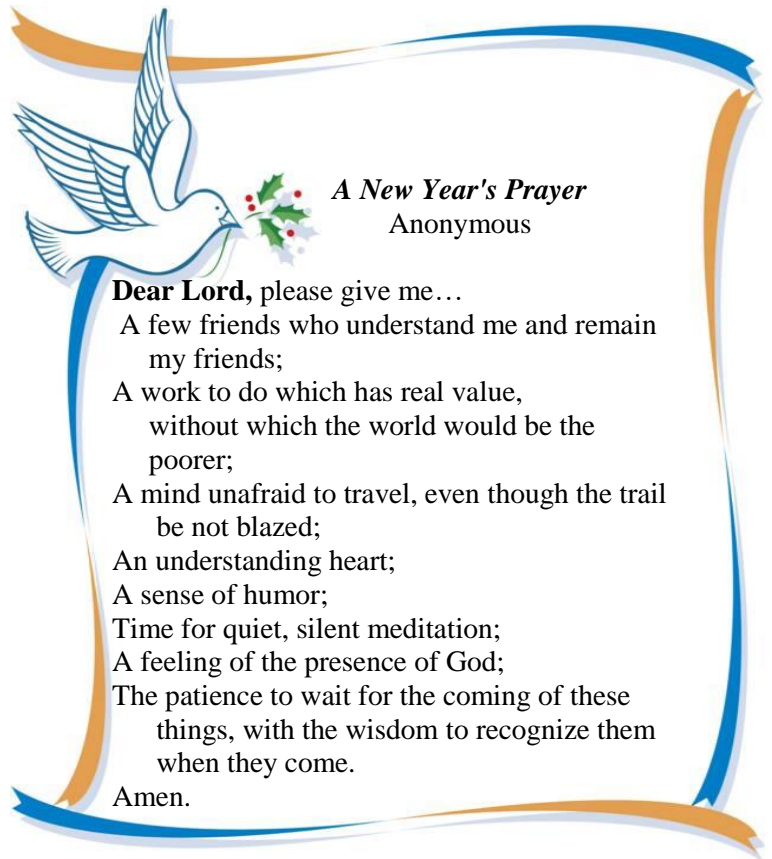
Obviously, time is one of our most precious possessions. We can waste it. We can worry over it.
