Household Items: Toilet Paper; Paper Towel; Napkins; Kleenex; Baggies, all sizes; Laundry Soap; Hand Soap; Dish Soap; Aluminum Foil; Plastic Wrap; etc.

Personal Care Items: Deodorant; Toothpaste and Toothbrushes; Hair Brushes; Body Wash; Body Lotion; Razors; Shampoo; Conditioner; Feminine Hygiene Products; etc.
