## Student Technology Policy - 2017-2018

Roncalli High School provides technology resources to students, faculty and staff to promote the development of young men and women of competence, conscience, and compassion through an integrated academic, spiritual, and extra-curricular program. It is expected that technology is to be used in a reasonable, ethical, moral, and legal manner in accordance with the mission statement, beliefs, and values of Roncalli High School. The Internet is a global network connecting many millions of computers. The Internet is an environment of independent, unregulated resources that can change on a daily basis. This resource is used similar to the way books, magazines, newspapers and DVD's are used in an educational setting.

Roncalli High School is preparing students for the 21st Century by offering up-to-date computer resources to complement the curriculum. The Internet is a valuable tool offering a vast number of resources. It is our expectation that the school's network, internet access, PC's, and notebooks provided to the students, as well as their own personal devices are to be used in a reasonable, efficient, ethical, moral and legal manner in accordance with our mission. Computer hard drives and cloud storage will be treated like student lockers. Administrators may review files and communications to maintain system integrity and ensure that students are using the system responsibly. This extends to personal devices used at school. Students are responsible for following the guidelines for appropriate use and bear the consequences for misuse. Assigned passwords are to be kept confidential. Identifying stickers and serial numbers must remain intact. Assigned notebooks are not to be shared with other students. Devices must be kept in protective cases provided by the school.

### **The following are NOT permitted:**

- Accessing, displaying or sending pornographic or offensive material
- Accessing, displaying or sending materials that are derogatory toward any race, religion, culture, ethnic group, gender or sexual orientation.
- Using the Internet for transmission of materials in violation of local, state or federal regulations.
- Using obscene language
- Cyberbullying
- Violation of copyright laws
- Tampering with, misusing, abusing or vandalizing any hardware, software, or security measures
- Trespassing in others' files, folders or works
- Associating the school name or information in a negative manner on websites, social networks, or blogs, etc.
- Using Apps or proxy servers to gain access to blocked Internet sites.

The student will not have computer privileges until this form is signed and dated by both parent and student.
